

Tuition/Fees Payment

Please Read!!

Registration/Enrollment for SOE Continuing Education courses **will still** be handled through the SOE Continuing Education office – **NOT** RamWeb. **Payment** for these courses (**except contract/Annenberg courses**) will be billed through the CSU Student Financial Services Office.

Payment for course registration is not needed at the time of enrollment.

Please do not send payment with your registration/enrollment.

You will be mailed a billing statement from the University following the payment policies described below.

Spring Three Part Billing – Registrations must be received by November 15, 2007. Registrations received after December 15 will be billed accordingly.

University Payment Plan

Any student who completes registration agrees to pay the University according to the payment terms documented in the Colorado State University Class Schedule under the Payment of Accounts section. Unless you officially withdraw from the University during the authorized withdrawal periods, you are obligated to pay the full amount of the assessment and are subject to grades regardless of whether you attend class. Late charges of 1.5% per month, and other penalties as described therein, may be assessed for late payment.

Students are permitted to pay for the primary charges of tuition, general student fees, and university technology fees in three installments each fall or spring term. Summer charges are due as billed.

Students who register after the first billing cycle of the semester will be billed two installment amounts of two-thirds and one-third, or a single installment of the full amount, depending on the date of your registration.

Tuition, general fees, and university technology fee charges are due in three monthly installments each term as follows:
